

WiFi and Internet Use Policy

This policy provides guidance as to the acceptable use of the Tremayne Hall's Wifi and internet access.

The Tremayne Hall has access to the internet and this is password protected, but the service is free to users of the hall. We do not attempt to restrict access to the internet or filter any internet content accessed by users. The Tremayne Hall Management Committee (THMC) will not provide any technical support for this system nor guarantee availability, speed of service or a continuous connection.

The provision of an operational wifi connection to the internet service cannot itself be a condition of hire and may not be specified or requested in the hiring agreement.

The THMC therefore wishes to make it clear to hirers that:

1. Access is provided free of charge to the hirer
2. **Hirers must not use the internet facilities for: Unlawful or illegal activity, commercial purposes, unless authorised by the THMC in writing, uploading computer viruses or hacking, uploading defamatory, offensive or illegal material, breaching confidentiality, or intellectual property rights or interrupting the provision of service to other hall users.**
3. The THMC do not provide technical support for the system
4. THMC does not guarantee availability or that users devices will work successfully at the hall.
5. The THMC is not responsible for the purpose to which hirers put the internet or the websites visited.
6. The THMC does not take any responsibility for any malware, hacking or other unwanted effects from use.
7. It is the hirers responsibility to protect themselves from the above effects and to set privacy, security and content access levels on their devices to also prevent access to personal data.
8. It is the hirers responsibility to monitor children's access to the internet during their period of hire.
9. The THMC will not collect any personally identifiable information when providing these facilities. The hall router may collect technical information from the hirers device to provide access to the internet which may be logged to detect crime or where necessary to block access from a specific device. The THMC will allow access to such information to any relevant authority as required to check for infringement of the law.
10. In using the Tremayne Hall's wifi, users will agree to indemnify both the THMC and the Trustees against all liabilities, claims, losses or damages (including legal fees and other expenses) that may arise from their connection to the Tremayne Hall's wifi.
